

Examination of Conscience Before Confession

There are those who have not been to Confession in a long time because they do not think they have committed any sins. In this and past bulletins, we have looked at some violations of the Ten Commandments that ought to be confessed. This summary is based on a Marian Press pamphlet entitled "How to Make a Good Confession."

7 and 10. You shall not steal. You shall not covet your neighbors goods. Do I respect the property and goods of others, or do I take what belongs to them? Have I returned stolen goods or made restitution for the value of them? Have I paid my just debts? Have I wasted time at work or in school? Have I spent money on excessive gambling or on things I don't need? Have money or possessions become my god? Have I failed to help the poor or those in need? Have I been envious of the wealth or possessions of others and wished harm on them? Have I been greedy in my pursuit of money and wealth?

8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. Have I always told the truth, or have I lied and gossiped about others behind their backs? Have I ruined the good name of another either by telling a lie about them or by revealing some hidden fault of theirs that no one has a right to know? Have I made up for my sins of lying or detraction by trying to restore the good name of another person? Have I broken a promise of confidentiality or secrecy in order to make someone else look bad or to give someone an unfair advantage? Am I sincere in my dealings with other people, or am I "two-faced"?
